Stand-up Tube Ponies How-to

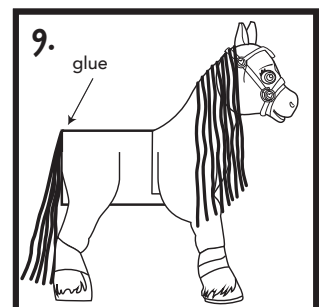
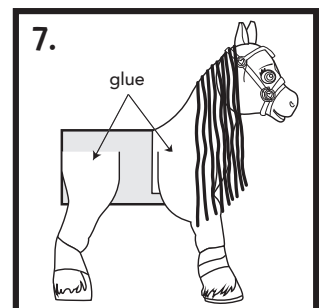
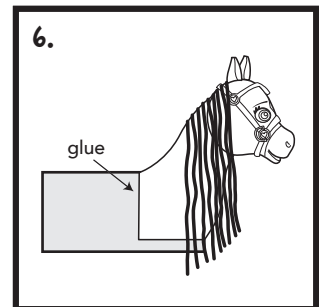
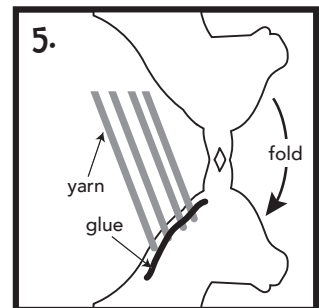
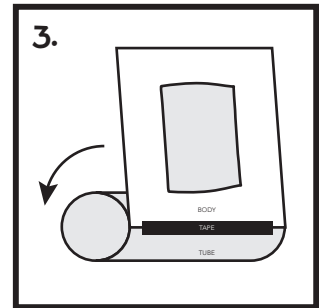
You will need

- Lightweight card stock
- 1 paper tube (like a toilet paper tube)
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- Tape
- Scissors
- Glue
- Yarn (any color)
- Sequins and glitter (optional)

Instructions

1. Print out coloring sheets and instructions.
2. Color and cut out body piece.
3. Wrap body piece around paper tube and tape ends together.
4. Color and cut out head, legs and saddle. If you want to decorate your saddle with sequins and glitter, now is the time!
5. For the mane, cut 10 pieces of yarn, glue to the back side of the head and fold head cut-out in half.
6. Once glue has dried, attach head to paper tube with glue.
7. On one side of tube, attach one front and one back leg with glue, as shown. Repeat on the other side.
8. Glue the saddle in place.
9. Finish with the tail by attaching 6 cut pieces of yarn to the inside end of the tube, as shown.
10. Adjust legs by bending slightly until your pony stands on its own.
11. Repeat using same stencils to create as many ponies as you wish.

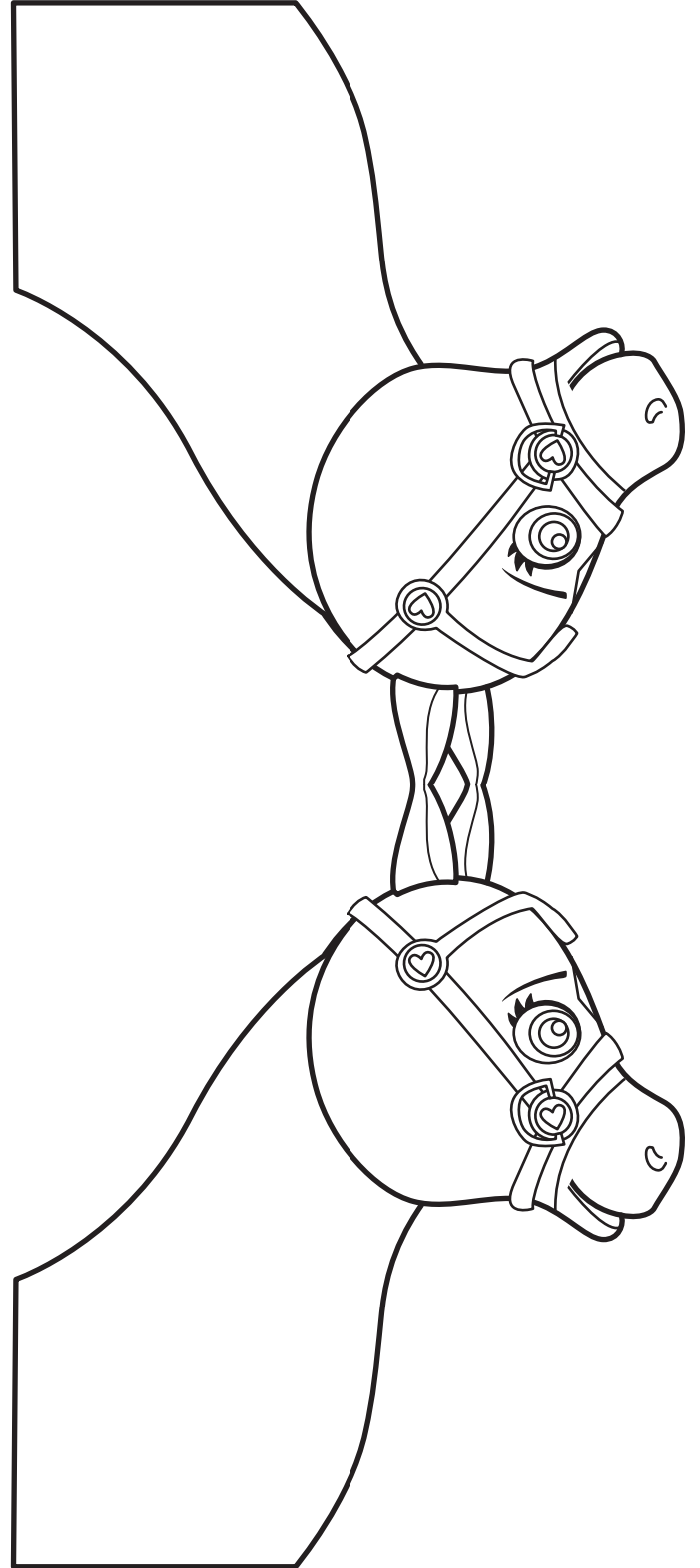
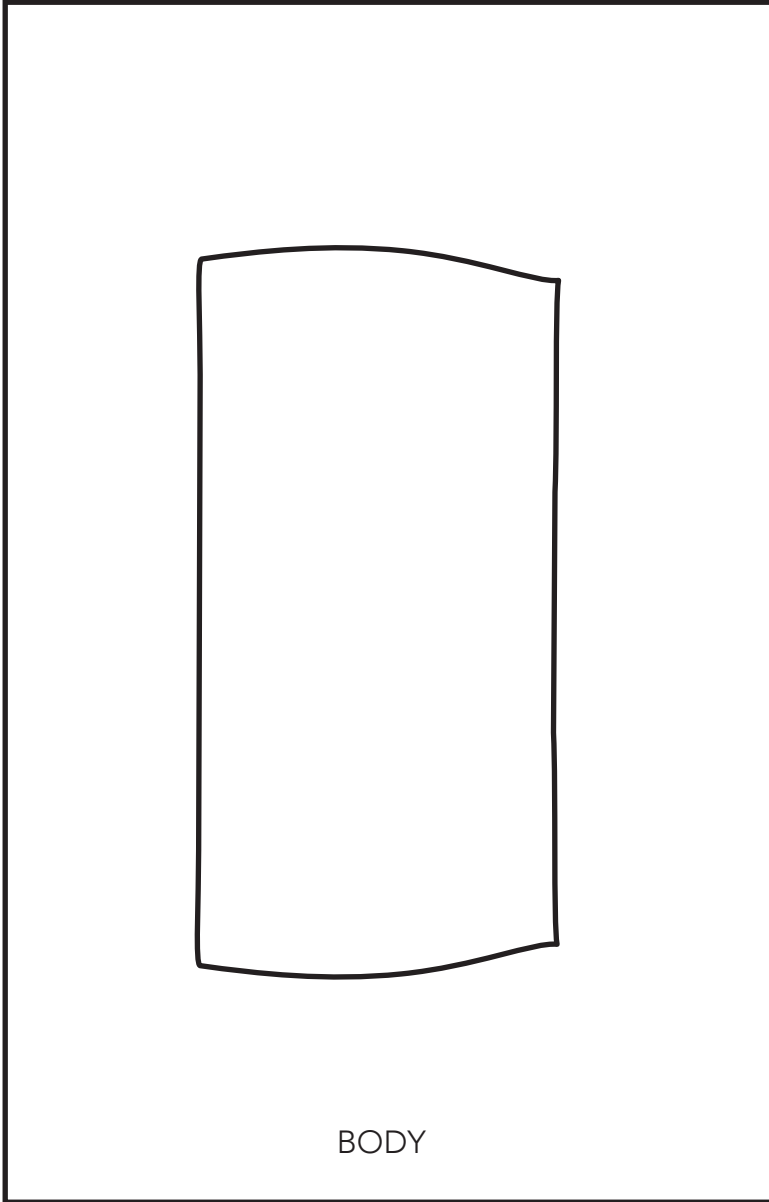
